What is Title 1 and what does it mean for our students?

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Title 1 is a federally funded program that provides supplemental instruction to ensure all students have resources to achieve in all academic areas.

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Schools qualify for Title 1 funds based on economic need. Schools like Lonedell R-14 that have 40% or more students from low income families are eligible to operate a school-wide Title 1 program.



Lonedell must identify areas of greatest need through comprehensive needs assessment.

School wide strategies include...

Strengthen the core academic program.

Increase the amount & quality of learning time.

Address needs of all learners, particularly low achieving students.

Provide professional training for teachers and para-educators.

Building relationships with families.
